For me, it's been seven years since the first time I went to Shadows, a wild and unpredictable Halloween party put on by the Anime and Manga Society of UNR.





Preston now is living his dream of programming for video games at 3G studios in Reno, NV and can't wait to see where his life will take him next!





Mark Oshiro

The Slants

Portland's The Slants are the first and only all-Asian American dance rock band in the world. They offer up catchy dance beats, strong hooks, and a bombastic live show that is "not to be missed" (The Westword). The Willamette Week says "While the band may well be best experienced live, Slants releases always promise a few blistering, note-perfect singles." The music is the perfect combination of 80's driven synth pop with hard-hitting indie, floor-filling beats which fans affectionately dub as "Chinatown Dance Rock."

They've been featured on NPR's "All Things Considered," IFC TV, Huffington Post, MTV, and over 1500 radio stations, tv shows, magazines, and websites worldwide.

17 international tours, including appearances in 46 of 50 U.S. states, have led to headlining showcases at major festivals such as SXSW, MusicfestNW, San Diego Comic-Con, Dragon Con. The band has also tour/provided support for The Decemberists, Mindless Self Indulgence, Girl Talk, Apl.De.Ap (of Black Eyed Peas), Blindpilot and Shonen Knife. In 2011, The Slants worked with the Department of Defense for a series of shows at U.S and NATO bases in Eastern Europe, dubbed "Operation Gratitude."

Every one of their last 5 music videos have gone viral, gaining tens of thousands of views within days; "You Make Me Alive" reached nearly a quarter million views in less than four months and is being broadcasted in 82 countries worldwide.

Two of their recent music videos feature martial arts choreography by Sammo Hung (The Matrix, Ip Man, & Enter the Dragon) and international stars Daniel Wu and Shu Qi.

They've won "Album of the Year" and "Editor's Choice" from dozens of magazines, including Willamette Week, LA Weekly, Shojo Beat, Village Voice, City Beat, and Rockwired.

Whether rocking music halls, anime conventions, maximum-security prisons, colleges, or army bases, it's clear that The Slants' infectious brand of "so damn good" music will leave you wanting more (MRU Magazine)

Both started making costumes in 2006, and began working on props professionally in 2008 when they co-founded The Props Shop. They also competed at conventions across California, and have won multiple high ranking awards for their costumes and props. Most days they can be found in their shop covered in wood shavings and foam dust, working on several commissions at a time.

WindoftheStars, aka Mel Hoppe, has been a geek all her life. Since she was young, she has been into comic books and video games. In 2004 she started to put her artistic energy into creating costumes from her favorite games, movies, comics, animes, mangas, and even creates original costumes of her own design. Since then she has created over 90 costumes for herself and others such as George R. R. Martin; many of which have won awards including Best of Show. Her colorful and elaborate costume works have been seen in online and print publications across the world including Cosmode, Kotaku, TokyoPOP, OtakuUSA and was featured in Anna Fischer's The Wild Places cosplay photo project. WindoftheStars has also had the honor of modeling her costumes at shows for Kotobukiya, DC Comics, and Bandai. In 2014 she was asked to be a Judge on the new cosplay show Call to Cosplay, which aired on Myx TV and CrunchyRoll. In that same year, she also was a judge and co-organizer for 2K's Borderlands The Pre-Sequel Cosplay Contest. When she is not working on costumes for herself, she is making high quality costumes for others or works at a top tier alterations shop in Northern Nevada as a professional tailor. The Pathfinder Society will be hosting a plethora of events, including con exclusive special adventures, for all role-playing enthusiasts. Whether you're a battle-hardened veteran or new to the gaming scene, Pathfinder has the adventure for you! No supplies or previous experience is necessary.

PF Mod: We Be Goblins! (levels 1-2)

The Licktoad goblins of Brinestump Marsh have stumbled upon a great treasure: fireworks! Unfortunately for them, the tribe member responsible for the discovery has been exiled for the abhorrent crime of writing (which every goblin knows steals words from your head). Therefore, the Licktoads' leader, His Mighty Girthness Chief Rendwattle Gutwad, has declared that the greatest heroes of the tribe must venture forth to retrieve the rest of the fireworks from a derelict ship stranded in the marsh.

PF Mod: Carrion Hill (levels 4-6)

Carrion Hill has long loomed over the surrounding swamps in eastern Ustalav, yet its rulers have shifted many times through the centuries. Only a few sinister scholars and curious minds know the true nature of the hill's original inhabitants: vile and depraved cultists of the Old Gods. Yet this morning, a dreadful recrudescence rises from the depths of buried nightmare in the vaults below Carrion Hill. A monster stalks the twisted alleys of the city, leaving destruction in its wake.



PF Mod: Crypt of the Everflame (levels 1-2)

The young heroes of the town of Kassen are ready for their coming-of-age ceremony, an old tradition where they retrieve a piece of the eternal flame burning in the tomb of the town's founder. Instead, they find the corpses of fellow townsfolk, dead bandits, and mysterious animated skeletons. The heroes must brave perils of the Crypt of the Everflame, discover the source of the corruption that has awakened an ancient evil, and defeat a menace that seeks vengeance against Kassen and its people.

PF Mod: Emerald Spire: Godhome (levels 3-5)

This level is home to a peaceful tribe of troglodytes who worship a mysterious arcane device. The heroes must placate or deactivate the strange machine in order to pass.

PF Mod: Emerald Spire: Splinterden (levels 2-4)

A ruthless band of outlaws discovered the Spire's strange properties months ago and decided to build a secret refuge in the dungeons.

PF Mod: Emerald Spire: The Cellars (levels 1-3)

The foundations of the tower are a confusing maze of vermin-infested chambers and clever pit traps. A dangerous undead spellcaster known as Gorloth, the Bone Priest, ambushes adventurers who blunder into the pits and spiderwebs.

PF Mod: Emerald Spire: The Drowned Level (lv 3-5)

Planar portals fed from the Elemental Plane of Water fill most of the chambers in this level with water. The heroes will have to find their way through surging currents and long, lightless swims to continue their exploration of the Spire.

PF Mod: Emerald Spire: Tower Ruins (levels 1-2)

The surface structure of the Spire consists of the ruins of the old Azlanti tower. A band of bloodthirsty goblins under the leadership of the bugbear chieftain Grulk lurks in the ruined tower.

PF Mod: Feast of Ravenmoor (levels 2-4)

For decades, the tiny village of Ravenmoor has existed quietly on the Lampblack River. Linked to the outside world only by an overgrown trail, the villagers are comfortable with their isolation. When a clerk in the city of Magnimar discovers that the village of Ravenmoor hasn't paid taxes in years, a tax collector is sent to the community to settle accounts. When the tax collector fails to return, however, a group of adventurers must travel to the town to investigate his disappearance.

PFS 5-03: The Hellknight's Feast (levels 5-9)

War between demons and the civilized peoples of the Inner Sea region has broken out in the Worldwound far to the north of Absalom, but many nations are ambivalent toward the cause. The Pathfinder Society, arranges a formal banquet to be hosted by newlyweds Michellia and Damian Blakros, at which the society's agents can attempt to sway the political opinions of Absalom's movers and shakers.

PFS 5-08: The Confirmation (levels 1-2)

Almost all Pathfinders undergo extensive training to learn the tricks of the trade, and their last test is the Confirmation, a special research project that involves fieldwork and is designed to simulate the initiates' future work as a Pathfinder. Although Confirmation is typically an individual affair, the society recently discovered a site on the Isle of Kortos that would be perfect for initiates but perhaps too dangerous to handle alone.

PFS 5-10: Where Mammoths Dare Not Tread (lv 7-11)

Despite several promising developments on the front lines, it's increasingly clear to the Pathfinder Society that fighting across the entire Worldwound would prove far more costly than approaching the Sky Citadel Jormurdun from the west. The society lacks in an established basecamp, so the PCs must travel to the Realm of the Mammoth Lords to win over the locals and secure a beachhead, all without falling prey to the area's powerful megafauna, savage demons, and relentless barbarian tribes.

PFS 5-24: Assault on the Wound (levels 3-7)

The Pathfinder Society embarks on its expedition to the lost Sky Citadel Jormurdun with a small army of allies in tow, but they are not the only ones seeking the dwarven fortress. Two of the Society's nemeses have rallied the fiends of Frostmire to crush the Pathfinders, hoping to buy the villains enough time to secure Jormurdun first. If the campaign is to succeed, the Society's forces will need bold leadership. Can the PCs lead their motley army to victory deep in the Worldwound?

PFS 5-99: The Paths We Choose (levels 3-7)

The failure of Mendev's wardstones set in motion not only a new crusade but also catalyzed a change in the Pathfinder Society's various factions. As the Pathfinders prepare to march on the Sky Citadel Jormurdun, members of the various factions scramble to consolidate their gains and neutralize their enemies.

**PFS 5-EX: Ruins of Bonekeep:
Level I (levels 3-7)**

An enemy of the Pathfinder Society recently found a hidden dungeon in a centuries-old siege fortress, but despite his best efforts to convert it into his base of operations, he failed. When a pair of Pathfinders encounter disaster while scouting out the entrance, the party must explore the first level of the dungeon to determine not just what attacked their comrades but also what dark power their nemesis nearly acquired.

**PFS 5-S2: Ruins of Bonekeep:
Level II (levels 3-7)**

A group of Pathfinders recently delved into the ruins of Bonekeep, a siege fortress destroyed centuries ago. There they discovered not only terrifying threats but also extraordinary treasures. Warded by the magic of a senior Pathfinder, the party must explore as much of Bonekeep as they can before the spell dissipates, lest they too are enslaved by the enchanted maze that looks hauntingly more familiar with each discovery.

**PFS 6-00: Legacy of the Stonelords
(levels 1-11)**

At long last, the Pathfinders have reached the lost Sky Citadel Jormurdun only to find it already occupied by fiends and subterranean foes. The Society must mount an epic offense to explore the immense subterranean city while simultaneously driving off the squatters within. If they succeed, the Pathfinders may discover that the greatest prize is not the mountain fortress itself but the treasure that lies at its heart. The adventure concludes Season 5, Year of the Demon.

PFS 6-01: Trial by Machine (levels 1-5)

More than a millennium has passed since the “machine mage” Karamoss’s failed siege of Absalom, and for years the Pathfinder Society has used upper reaches of his

subterranean siege tower as a training ground for initiates. During a routine drill, the once-dormant dungeon springs to life, and it will take all the PCs’ resourcefulness and skill to make it out alive.

**PFS 6-02: The Silver Mount
Collection (levels 3-7)**

The esteemed Blakros family, famous for their museum in Absalom, receives a large shipment of artifacts from Numeria but fears that the ever-vigilant Technic League will attack to reclaim its “stolen” property. When they request the help of Pathfinders to help guard the collection, the PCs discover that the Technic League is the least of their worries.

PFS 6-03: The Technic Siege (levels 5-9)

When the Pathfinder Society acquires a copy of A Thread of Silver, a written survey of some of Numeria’s most closely guarded sites, the Technic League dispatches its own agents to the Pathfinder lodge in Nantambu to recover the text and make an example of those who would investigate Numeria’s otherworldly secrets. Can the PCs prevent the League from stealing this valuable tome and destroying the Society’s foothold in the Mwangi Expanse? For levels 5-9.

PFS 6-04: Beacon Below (levels 7-11)

Thousands of years ago, a defeated order of Osirian sages sought refuge in the perilous Pillars of the Sun in central Osirian. Until recently they were presumed lost, but recent exploration has uncovered the fortress sanctum they left behind. When the PCs delve into one of its sealed halls, they find the sages’ millennia-old projects dormant but not dead.

**PFS 6-05: Slave Ships of Absalom
(levels 1-5)**

The metropolis of Absalom promotes commerce in its many forms, and although slavery is legal, it is increasingly common for citizens to frown on the institution. The practice becomes more questionable when an ally of the Pathfinder Society traces an attempt at supernatural surveillance through a slave. Sent as independent sleuths, the PCs must track down the source of this espionage, which takes them deep into underbelly of one of Absalom’s darkest industries.

**PFS Quest: The Silverhex
Chronicles (level 1)**

Shortly after performing a heist that enraged the local nobility, Ulisha, a curious and capable half-orc explorer, came across a collapsing stone circle and discovered Silverhex, an enchanted sickle used by druids millennia before. She did not have long to admire her find, for the nobles had posted a bounty to end her meddling for good. If you can raise enough money, she’s willing to sell Silverhex to you at a steep discount and then pay off her bounty.
